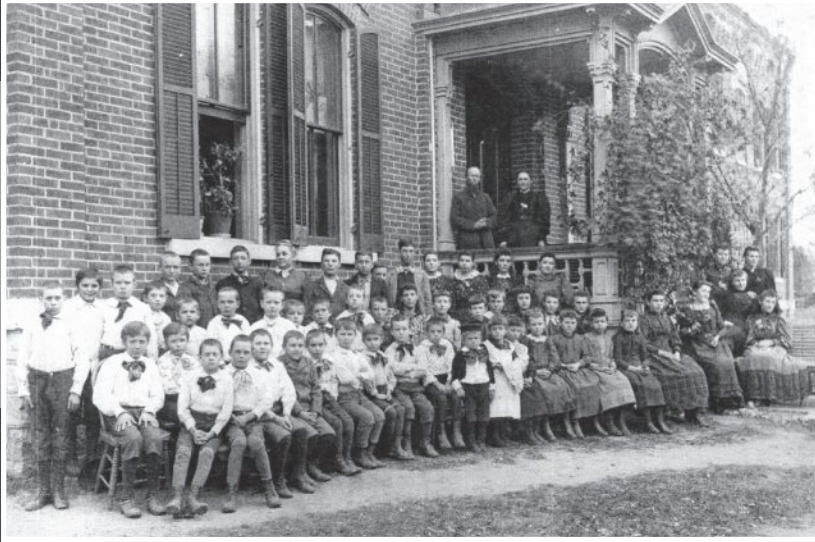
Our Mission

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Our History



1864

In 1864, the German Methodist Church founded a home in Warrenton, MO for orphan children; specifically the orphans of deceased soldiers.



1865

Mr. William H. Markham financed the first of the Methodist Children's homes in Saint Louis in 1865. Rev. W. W. Prottzman and his wife established the home to care for children who were torn from their families by disease and disaster of the Civil War.

1867

The Methodist Orphan Home Association was incorporated and Mr. William H. Markham was elected the first President of the Association of Trustees.



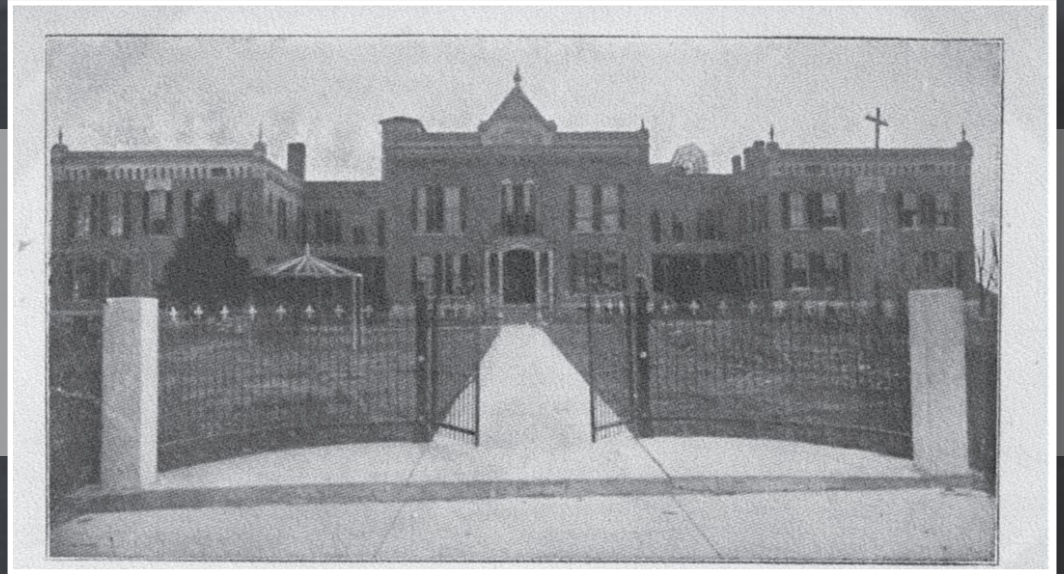
1870

The first Methodist Orphan Home was constructed at 3533 Laclede with the occupancy of 35 children.



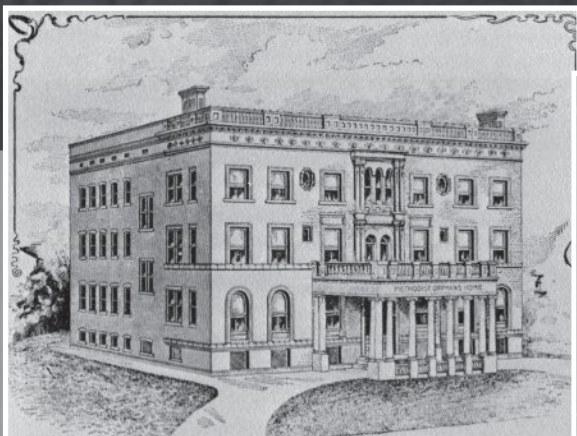
1876-1914

Mrs. John J. O'Fallon began an unprecedented service record of 38 years with the Methodist Orphan Home Association as President of the Board of Lady Managers.



1884

After operating under the name of Western Orphan Asylum and Educational Institute, the Warrenton Home changed its name to Central Wesleyan Orphan Home.



1896

Mr. Samuel Cupples presented a new building to Methodist Orphan Home at 4385 Maryland Avenue in memory of his wife, Mrs. Martha Kells Cupples. She was an active member of the Board of Directresses.



1913-1927

The Methodist Orphan Home opened a new building for boys at Bonhomme Avenue and continued to run the home on Maryland Avenue. The average number served in the two institutions was 100 children.



1915

The Methodist Episcopal Home for Girls changed its name to Epworth School for Girls. Miss Ella Stanard, who became Mrs. Fred Shoemaker after they met on the first Board and married, was instrumental in getting the home incorporated into the Woman's Home Missionary Society of the Saint Louis Conference.

EPWORTH SCHOOL FOR GIRLS, ST. LOUIS

HERBERT B. RHODES, D.D.

Epworth School for Girls, St. Louis, Missouri, after several years of well-directed and successful effort under the head of "Conference Work," was received into full membership by the Woman's Home Missionary Society in October, 1919. As the only home of its kind, offering shelter, protection, and Christian culture to young girls denied these blessings by cruel circumstances, it has in the past years helped many to a better life. Of the several hundred girls who have thus far shared its benefits, over 80% have been saved and fitted for useful and happy lives. The average number of girls in residence is twenty-five, and they come from the juvenile court, the Children's Aid Society, and other social agencies of the city. The school is endorsed by the Chamber of Commerce in St. Louis as 100% efficient in its fulfillment of its declared purpose so to train hand, head, and heart that those committed to its care may come out with transformed life and character; and many are the testimonies which prove how well it has succeeded ever since its inception.

It is, as its name indicates, a school, graded to the eighth grade, and with qualified teachers in charge of industrial work, including plain and fancy sewing and basketry. Special gymnasium exercises are under supervision twice a week, and music and expression work are taken. There are at present five resident workers, with Mrs. G. E. Keck as superintendent, and Miss Trumbull, a deaconess, as assistant, who has done good service for the school, but will leave this summer to



1919

Epworth School for Girls was received into full membership of the Woman's National Home Missionary Society of the Methodist Episcopal Church and their first Woman's Board of Managers was organized. That same year, Epworth graduated its first class of girls from the eighth grade.



1920's-1930's

The Central Wesleyan Home reached its peak occupancy with two modern cottages that created a home-like environment.



1922

Epworth School for Girls moved to a beautiful estate on Elm Avenue with a capacity of 50 girls. They elected Mrs. Henby president of the Board of Managers and became one of the charter agencies of the St. Louis Community Council and the St. Louis Community Fund, later known as the St. Louis Planning Council and the United Charities of St. Louis and St. Louis County.



1923

Epworth School for Girls was one of the first 50 agencies that received funds from the Community Fund Drive.

1924

The Methodist Orphan Home was admitted to the Child Welfare League of America. They followed recommendations to close the boys' home in Clayton, and moved younger boys to their Maryland home.



1927

A Mother's Aid Program was started by the Methodist Orphan Home as well as the first fostering system established in Missouri.

EPWORTH SCHOOL DEDICATES NEW \$150,000 ADDITION

Two New Buildings at Girls' School Completed—Lions Guests at Luncheon Yesterday.

The officials and many friends of the Epworth School for Girls, 20 East Pacific Avenue, attended the dedication Sunday of the two new structures just completed. The additional buildings, valued at \$75,000 each, were started a year ago and are the result of many years of careful thought and effort on the part of the Epworth League and Home Missionary Societies of the Methodist Episcopal Church.

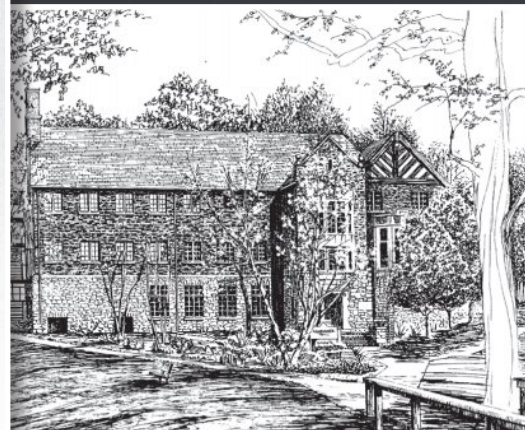
The additions will provide much needed housing facilities for the members of the school numbering about 45 girls in school season. According to Miss Norling, Superintendent, it is not a reform school, but a place for problem girls who receive training and supervision particularly adapted for their individual needs.

The Lions Club which has lent assistance to the school were their guests at luncheon yesterday. A film showing the operations of the newly completed Bagnell Dam at Bagnell, Mo., furnished by the Union Electric Light and Power Company, was part of the program.

Mrs. J. F. Shoemaker after whom one building is named, presided at the dedication ceremonies Sunday, with Mrs. W. Henby, president of Epworth School. The second building will be known as Henby Hall.

Others participating in the program included: Rev. T. Ross Hicks of the First Methodist Church, Rev. E. F. Lewis, D. D., Superintendent of St. Louis Dist; the choir of Grace M. E. Church S. Louis; Mrs. Robert W. Kelsoe, Director Community Fund; Dr. James E. Crowther, of Grace M. E. Church; Mr. Fred Rauch, Treasurer, member of building committee; Mrs. W. H. Goode, National pres. of Woman's Home Missionary Society; Mrs. Frank Dairs, Bureau Secretary and Miss Maude Norling, Supt. of the school.

A reception and tea in Henby Hall followed the ceremonies.



1930

The Jubilee Fund gave Epworth \$100,000 as one of the Golden Jubilee projects under the National Missionary Society to build Shoemaker and Henby Halls.



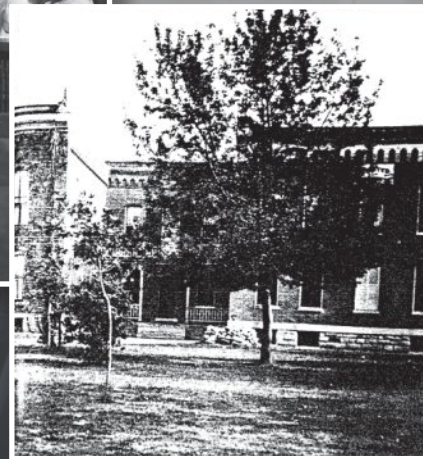
1937

The St. Louis Children's Aid Society instituted a cooperative plan with the Methodist Orphan Home and established a diagnostic health center known as the Washington University Dispensary.



1939

Mrs. Robert Duckworth conducted a study that led to the consolidation of the Central Wesleyan Orphanage and the Methodist Orphan Home in 1939.



1947

After the merge, the Methodist Orphan Home moved to a temporary home on Waterman Avenue, placing 75 children in foster care and housing 25 until a new facility was built.

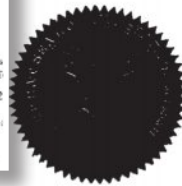

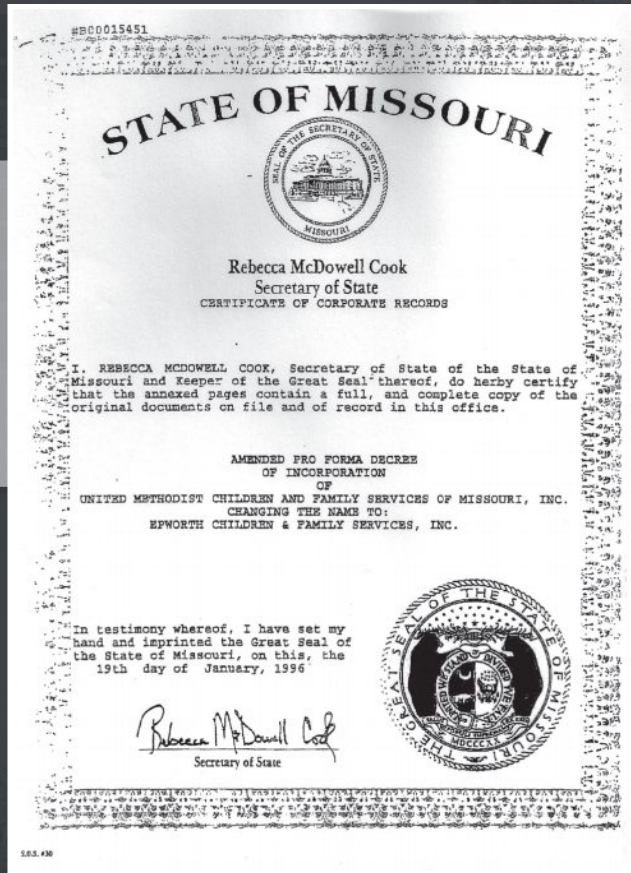

After being informally referred to as Epworth for two decades, the Methodist Children's Service of Missouri changed its name to Epworth Children & Family Services.

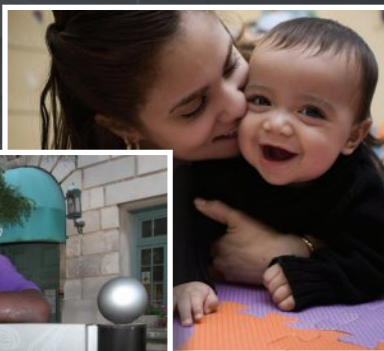


2000

Epworth merged with Youth Emergency Services, established in 1968, to help runaway and homeless youth.



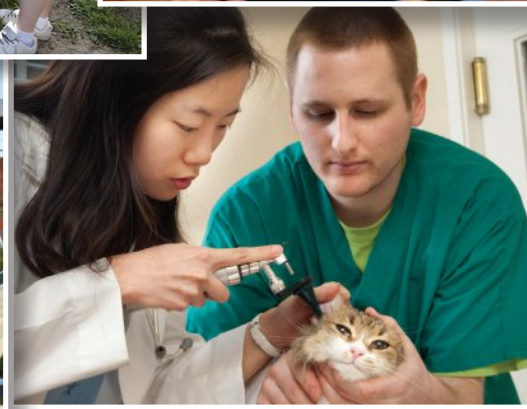
2006

Provides violence prevention and character education to help children develop the skills they need to make positive decisions in life that ensures academic and social success.

**RESIDENTIAL & INTENSIVE TREATMENT: 103**

Provides a safe and stable living environment while youth ages 11-18 work through emotional and behavioral issues that often stem from a history of abuse or neglect.

**SPECIAL EDUCATION SCHOOL: 165**

Serves students grade K – 12 who display behaviors that impede educational progress at their home schools.

**STREET OUTREACH SERVICES (SOS): 1,625**

Supports youth 11-21 who are experiencing homelessness, housing instability or unhealthy home lives, educates them about their options and encourages them to obtain permanent, safe housing.

**TRANSITIONAL & INDEPENDENT LIVING PROGRAMS (TLP/ILP): 769**

Teaches important life skills including budgeting, job readiness and parenting in an apartment setting. The ultimate goal is for youth ages 16-21 to care for themselves emotionally, physically and financially.

**YOUTH EMERGENCY SERVICES (YES): 228**

Provides food and housing in a safe, nurturing environment to youth experiencing homelessness or family crisis.
